Gabriele Pettinaroli – Italy (Saturday)

This year we are lucky to have Gabrielle from Italy for our Championship show.

In 1978 Gabriele was appointed international specialist judge for German Shepherds,

selection judge in 1980 and S.V. breed judge in 1983.

Gabriele has judged all over the world, including Germany, all of Europe, Indonesia, Japan, China, Central and South America, Serbia, Australia and New Zealand.

Sharon Ballantyne's Official Resume – Judging Sunday

I Reside in Queensland Australia, my occupation is Logistics Coordinator & Export Documentation Manager. My career background includes working for an advertising company and in the Local Laws area for a Local Council.

I was born and raised in an atmosphere, which centered on German Shepherd Dogs and from an early age my parents encouraged me to become involved with the breed in all aspects of their care, well-being and training. My Mother Diane established the Kantenna Prefix in 1964 and together within our own breeding programme we have bred the Gold & Silver National Medal winner *Ch. Kantenna Nutmeg, Silver National Medal winner *Ch. Kantenna Love Match, National class winners *Kantenna Venus De Milo, *Kantenna Wicked, *Kantenna Sarratoga and *Kantenna Liz Hurley. We have bred many Breed Surveyed, Excellent Select, Excellent Merit and Excellent graded dogs including several Australian Champions. To date we have bred over 100 GSD's through the Australian Hip and Elbow scheme.

My continued interest and passion for the breed, has now taken me into my adult life where I have enjoyed handling many top Australian and Imported dogs including the famous National Gold Medal Wining male *Ch. Kwint vom Juerikstall (Imp Italy) and also the National Gold Medal winner *Demtori Analyze This. I have also had the privilege of handling many Best in Show Winners, class winners and place getters at Nationals and Specialty Shows with dogs from our kennel but also from many of the top kennels in Australia.

At Queensland German Shepherd Dog Club level, I have held numerous positions including Club Secretary, Treasurer, Vice President, Breed Affairs Registrar, Show Secretary, Show Training Coordinator and I am currently the President for the club. I attend most major interstate and local specialist shows, regularly attend meetings and raise funds towards the running of shows and trials.

As of July 2017 I have been accepted as a GSDCA Aspiring Breed Surveyor.

GERMAN SHEPHERD DOG ADVISORY COUNCIL NEWS

Long Stock Coats

A request to support an appeal to NZKC for extending the time (an extra 10 years from 2020) for establishing a gene pool of long stock coats in New Zealand was received from SIGSL. The committee voted to support this appeal and also any appeals of this topic from other German shepherd clubs of New Zealand. It is a challenging process getting a database of the long stock coats currently being exhibited in New Zealand. The Registrar has asked if all clubs could please provide a marked catalogue to the GSDAC secretary. This would be appreciated.

Health Database

As a group of German Shepherd owners and breeders we are fortunate to have a member, Janet King, who has undertaken to collect data on health issues with our beloved breed. Any data collected is always vital and many of us can reflect on data collected by Malcolm Willis, the geneticist. Like all things, data is only as useful as the data that is submitted. With this in mind, can we please encourage clubs and members to submit information on any health related diseases, and/or disorders to Janet King (clay.king@).

Hip and Elbow scores

I find it very reassuring to notice the improvement in the breed since I was last actively involved. One of the health and disability disorders that have improved, yet still needs to be kept in the front of our minds is hip and elbow dysplasia. There has been talk for a number of years on ways to keep improving hip and elbow health disorders in our breed. Many of us have possibly had the heartache of owning a dog that has had hip or elbow problems. It is heart breaking to witness our pets in pain and discomfort.

It has been recommended that, we would like to encourage all German Shepherd clubs to consider a hip and elbow score as a prerequisite for an excellent grading. It would require a key icon in the catalogue such as we use now for breed survey animals.

The Advisory Council welcomes your feedback on any of these issues. It is about keeping the connections flowing between clubs and Advisory Council. There may be other concerns or puzzles that your members have, please let us know, together we can achieve great things for the breed we all love.

Breed Survey heights

Notification to all clubs and members that, as from February 28th 2018, there is a proposed change to height allowances for Breed Survey Class I and Breed survey Class II.

The new height ratios are:

Sex	Minimum	Maximum
Dogs Class 1	60 cm	65 cm
Bitches Class 1	55 cm	60 cm
Dogs Class 2	59 cm	66 cm
Bitches Class 2	54 cm	61 cm
Animals outside these limits will be deemed unclassified and can complete a structural assessment.		

Breed Survey and Structural Assessment

Breed survey fee is \$45. Structural Assessment is \$15.

A decision was made that, if an owner has paid for a breed survey and that survey cannot be fulfilled, (e.g. a dog fails the initial assessment for a breed survey) the owner can choose to have a structural assessment instead on that day at no extra costs. Noted that it can only be on the same day that the survey was to happen.

Decision Time is around the Corner

The WUSV

The Verein für Deutsche Schäferhunde (Society for German Shepherd Dogs) abbreviated, as SV is the dog club founded by Max von Stephanitz and his colleague, Arthur Meyer, in 1899. The SV set forward the standards of the German Shepherd Dog breed. It controls every aspect of the GSD in Germany. It is in effect the Kennel Control for German Shepherd Dogs in Germany and an extremely influential affiliate of the FCI. (Advice from CDO).

The WUSV “Harmonization Programme”

What is the WUSV Harmonisation Program and why we being asked to comply?

- The objective of the WUSV is to have a standardised breeding specification based on minimum breeding requirements across all WUSV Member Clubs. In that process, the standard of the GSD globally in the areas of construction, health, temperament and character will not only raise, but also be uniformly standardized and consolidated.
- Dogs that fulfil the minimum breeding requirements specification will have their names and details entered into the WUSV studbook. Only dogs that are entered into the Stud Book may be used for breeding in WUSV member club countries.
- Every WUSV member club must comply with the program and may have the opportunity to negotiate their own path forward with the WUSV.

Why should I care about the WUSV Harmonisation program?

- The WUSV Harmonisation program includes many aspects of the GSD, not just breeding/show or obedience/trialling. In order to meet the requirements fully, amongst the other items, we must endeavour to demonstrate that animals used for breeding possess the qualities of trainability and sound character/temperament. Characteristics: Purpose and Usage: Versatile Utility, Herding, Guard and Service Dog. Temperament: The German Shepherd Dog must be of well-balanced temperament, steady of nerves, self-assured, absolutely `at ease (except when provoked) and good natured as well as attentive and easy to train. He must possess instinctive drive, resilience and self - confidence to be suitable as a companion, watch dog, protection, service and herding dog.
- This is a very important benefit to the breed and all breeders worldwide.

Harmonisation Components

To introduce the character and ZAP assessment, BH, AD and IPO around the world as a basis for its harmonizing the global implementation of standardized breeding and training for the German Shepherd Dog in line with the SV's applicable constitutions and regulations.

What does this mean for New Zealand?

For New Zealand to remain affiliated with the SV in Germany we need to follow their direction and proposals, this includes having access to contracting SV judges for our shows.

Looking at what Australia is doing

This information was taken from the Australian “The German Shepherd Dog Quarterly National Review”

Australia has voted on 28th July to include

- Working test for Puppies (ZAP)
- Working test ZAP plus BH

- Maximum number of studs per year being 90
- Maximum number of litters, females – 3 litters during 24 months
- Line breeding limits.
- Australia's Hip Dysplasia and Elbow Dysplasia schemes to continue
- Minimum show grading of good to be a pre-requisite for a Breed Survey.
- Breed surveys are either a pass or fail, not class 1 or 2
- Gaining permission from the ANKC for members to participate in IPO
- The gun test will be introduced to GSD shows in the open classes to gain an excellent

ZAP Test – a brief summary

What is ZAP (zuchtanlageprüfung) – Rating of mental and physical breeding disposition.

The character judgments of the German Shepherd are principally designed to prove the dogs are environmental sound and socially friendly, and meet the requirements of the “working dog”, by determining the dogs hereditary behavioural traits assets required for developing breeding qualities.

In 2017 the German Convention voted to introduce character judgments, and support members to teach a dog to perform BH/IPO standards

Why character test?

- An increasing awareness of societal demands and a concern of dangerous dogs.
- The need to have dogs even tempered dogs that are strong in nerve but not excessively aggressive.
- Develop an understanding of unwanted behaviour traits and disorders (character deficiencies) and to help prevent these emerging in the future so that dog ownership is accepted by the wider society.
- Use the knowledge gained from biological behaviour research to better understand the dog's behaviour; inherited and/or acquired, and between fear and aggression.

What happens in the ZAP character test?

The dog's behaviour and its flexibility is recorded when the dog is confronted to different stimuli, and a conclusion can be made on the dog's nature based on its behaviour.

Obedience commands are to be kept to a minimum as to assess the dog's character.

Character judgment includes

Impartiality – The dog allows an unknown person to touch different body points.

Social behaviour – Interaction with people

Noise sensitivity – The dog is subjected to different noises e.g. rattling, engine noises, and gun testing.

Certainty of Movements – Sensitivity to heights. Looking at a dog's movement - walking across a table/plank and on the flat ground. Assessing how the dog plays with their owner and an unknown person. Looking at how the dog plays with their owner and an unknown person with items like a ball (willingness to find).

Basic Nature – Behaviour in isolation when meeting an unknown person.

Planned implementation

This test is designed for dogs that are between the age of 9 and 13 months, and is the prerequisite for the breed survey. At this stage it is voluntary.

Once the dog has passed the character judgment and ZAP, the dog must past the breed survey before it can be breed from without restrictions.

The character test can be repeated once if the dog has a negative result the first time.

The owner will receive a report of the assessments and its individual data – age, gender, condition, husbandry conditions, and future intended use.

The character judgment is listed on the pedigree and the dog owner receives a certificate and completed assessment sheets.

What is a BH test?

BH (Begleithund) is a companion test done in two parts. Part A - Obedience, Part B - Traffic

What is AD?

· AD is an endurance title available through the FCI, to participating countries. Australia has an equivalent test known as ET, which is available to all members.

What is an IPO (International Working Test)?

· IPO has three elements Tracking, Obedience and Protection. Whilst the protection element is the best known and held in awe by many, it must be emphasized that the dog must be under control before the protection phase is commenced. Hence the BH is prerequisite for IPO.

Summary

Australian clubs and their GSDCA (governing body) have already implemented many of the "Harmonisation Programme" proposals.

- They have a hip and elbow scoring system that is officially recorded and recognised.
- They already required all open class dogs to be hip and elbow x-rayed and breed surveyed to acquire an excellent.

Considerations

New Zealand is a smaller country than Australia and we have not got -

- Numbers of GSD clubs or members
- The number of dogs or a large gene pool
- An infrastructure to record hips and elbows in a collective database.
- NZKC recognition for Breed Surveying and character testing requirements.
- ZAP, BH, IPO or qualified character trainers.

We have representation on the WUSV board through Louis Donald (Australia) and he will come to New Zealand to help us develop our own pathway towards WUSV Harmonisation. I believe that New Zealand's unique requirements will be considered differently than Australia and the expectations for New Zealand to comply will be more lenient and over an extended period of time.
